These classes will take place every third Tuesday starting October 2008 and ending March 2009. The classes will be from 7:30-3:00 PM.
- Leadership Essentials helps build leaders by teaching skills such as visioning, strategy and goal setting, performing teams, managing change, and more. This program will meet for nine sessions every other Friday beginning November 2008 and take place from 8:00AM-12:00PM. This program is in collaboration with St. Ambrose University and Integrity Integrated. Dr. Randy Richards of St. Ambrose, Ginny Wilson-Peters, and Susan Zelnio will facilitate different sessions.

Additionally, eight to 15 hours outside the class time will be required for each course
